What is Purpose-T

Pressure Ulcer Risk Assessment Framework:

Designed to identify adults at risk of developing pressure ulcers.

Utilises colours to indicate risk:



Blue: No pressure ulcer / Not at risk



Yellow: No pressure ulcer / At risk



Pink: Pressure ulcer category 1 or above / Scarring from previous pressure ulcer

Incorporates three phases:

1. Screening
2. Full Assessment
3. Assessment Decision

Why the Change?

In comparison with existing risk assessment tools, Purpose-T:

- Quickly identifies individuals not at risk and schedules reassessment.
- Removed need for a full assessment in low-risk cases.
- Integrates skin assessment.
- Distinguishes between primary and secondary prevention.
- Evidence-Based.
- Best Practice: Recommended by NWCSP (2023).
